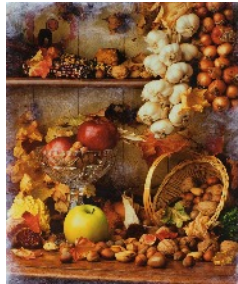

Recipe: Greek Style Herb & Feta Crostini by LaVon Plumlee

Hors D'oeuvres: Crostini with Greek Style Herb and Feta Crostini:

Heat oven 350 degrees

1 Baguette sliced ¼ inch thick

Rub with peeled garlic cloves

Drizzle one side with olive oil or melted butter.

Bake 10 – 15 minutes without turning until toasted. Cool

(Or substitute Costco Sourdough Baguette Crisp for baguette)

Topping for sliced Baguette or Costco Sourdough Crisps:

2 tomatoes diced

¼ cup Kalamata olives or artichoke hearts drained, sliced or chopped

2 tbsp lemon juice

1 pinch red pepper flakes (to taste)

2-3 garlic cloves, minced or pressed

3 tbsp mint, chiffonade (chopped)

½ tsp dried thyme or oregano

Salt, pepper and olive oil to taste

8 oz feta cheese crumbled

Toss together tomatoes, olives or artichoke hearts, red chili flakes, garlic, mint, parsley, thyme, salt, pepper and oil. When tomato mixture is well combined, fold in feta cheese.

When ready to serve, place a generous spoonful on crostini slices and serve as is or place on a baking tray and warm crostini in a 350 F oven for about 10 minutes.
