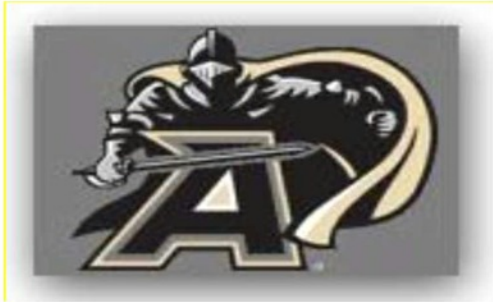

Recipe: Easy Turkey Tetrazzini

3 cups sliced fresh mushrooms	1/2 cup cooking sherry
1 cup minced onion	1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
1 cup minced red/green bell pepper	1 teaspoon salt
2 (10.75 ounce) cans condensed cream of mushroom soup	1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
2 cups chicken broth	4 cups chopped cooked turkey breast
1-2 cups shredded sharp Cheddar cheese	1 cup grated Parmesan cheese
1 10-ounce package frozen green peas	paprika to taste

Directions

1. Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add 12 ounces of wide egg noodles and cook for 8 to 10 minutes or until al dente; drain and set aside.
2. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).
3. Meanwhile, melt butter in a large saucepan over medium heat. Add mushrooms, onion and bell pepper and saute until tender. Stir in cream of mushroom soup and chicken broth; cook, stirring, until heated through. Stir in pasta, Cheddar cheese, peas, sherry, Worcestershire sauce, salt, pepper and chicken. Mix well and transfer mixture to a lightly greased 11x14 inch baking dish. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and paprika.
4. Bake in the preheated oven for 25 to 35 minutes, or until heated through.
